JVCS to Host Fall Event 2020

JVCS will celebrate Christian education on Thursday, October 8, at 7:00 PM, when they host Daywind recording artist Joseph Habedank, a GRAMMY® nominated, Dove Award winning singer/songwriter.

Concert tickets are free, but required. To comply with our city's current guidelines, tickets will be limited to well-below seating capacity to allow for the recommended six feet of social distancing in our auditorium. Beginning August 27, you may get your tickets by following the link on our website or on our Facebook. Tickets will not be available at the door. Guests will be given the opportunity to cover the costs of the concert or support the school by donating at the door.

TAKE YOUR SEAT CAMPAIGN

"The Lord has done great things for us, and we are glad." Psalm 126:3.

The Chair Campaign set a goal to raise \$1 million for the new construction project spread over the 730 seats in the new auditorium, which is about \$1,400 per chair. So far, 514 chairs have been covered, leaving 260 seats to raise (just over \$300,000). More than 110 people have given toward the Take Your Seat Campaign. We are so thankful for your generosity. Will you help cover the last 260 seats?

The total building cost was \$5,383,000 and almost \$5 million has been raised. The bank loan balance has been paid down to \$613,263, after peaking at \$1,300,000. Great progress has been made!
