Jonathan Koel and Elisabeth Hamilton were selected as alternates.


This is Elaina's fourth year being selected for this honor.

JVC Fourth Grade Engages in Junior Achievement

JVC fourth grade students had the exciting opportunity to engage in an entrepreneurial learning experience through Junior Achievement's "Our Region" program. This initiative allowed students to explore the essential traits common to successful entrepreneurs and understand how they use resources to produce goods and services within a community.

Throughout the five sessions, the students delved into the fundamental tasks faced by business owners and navigated the complexities of business problem-solving.

They also participated in a handson manufacturing and trade experience, which helped them grasp the intricacies of the supply chain in a practical way.

One of the favorite activities for this class was running a hotdog stand.

Additionally, the students used their imaginations by thinking about what business they might want to start. Mauer Niederbaumer made a plan to have mail delivered using underground tunnels, while Crosby Pfamatter had the idea of making moving outdoor sidewalks.

They also visited about how many of their parents have started and currently own their own businesses.

Mara Norby, Development Coordinator for JVC, has been a volunteer with Junior Achievement for four years, teaching our fourth grade students about these concepts each year. She says, "I enjoy witnessing the students learn skills that will benefit them throughout their lives."
